



2013 KTM Mainland Cross Country Series



Entry: Enter on the day.

Entry fee: Free (*sponsorship kindly provided by KTM New Zealand and host clubs*)

License requirements: MNZ rules apply so all competitors must have a current MNZ racing license. Day licenses will be available to purchase on the day at sign in and you must be a current financial member of an MNZ affiliated motorcycle club.

Race format: Junior races will last for duration of 1hr30min.
Juniors under the age of 16yrs must have a parent or guardian sign them in.
Senior races will last for duration of 3hrs.

Junior classes are as follows:

- 10-16yrs 85cc** (up to 85cc 2-stroke, up to 150cc 4-stroke air cooled, and up to 150cc 4-stroke water cooled 12yrs and up only)
- 12-16yrs 125cc** (up to 200cc 2-stroke, and up to 300cc 4-stroke 14yrs and up only)

Senior classes are as follows:

- Vets** (35-44yrs)
- Super Vets** (45yrs+)
- Unders** (up to 200cc 2-stroke, 300cc 4-stroke)
- Overs** (over 200cc 2-stroke, 300cc 4-stroke)

NO ATVS.

The organizer reserves the right to change, remove or combine classes depending on entry numbers.
Novice class entrants who are obviously more skilled than those riders for whom the class is intended for may be promoted by the organizer.

Race Numbers: All machines must have clear easy to read numbers on all three number plates. If your number cannot be read, you will not be lap scored.

Points: Points will be awarded under the current FIM system. Four out of five rounds will count towards series points. Must be at final round.

Tear-offs: Tear-offs are not permitted at any rounds.
