The second section held the second test which was a little shorter in length and more open faster tracks. I was too conservative over the blind brows that held nothing but wide open rolling hills but still a solid time.

The lap was completed with a few creek crossings that caught a few out over the remaining sections.

The third test of the day was held at the start of the second lap. I had loosened up a little more and flowed better through the drying trail. Again no crashes and a good time was posted.

At the end of the second lap the Intermediates day was done but the Experts had another section that was to be tight on time. After pinning it through this section I arrived at the check point with heaps of time and collected the win.
